With tiles and under floor heating throughout make it ideal for young families and less able visitors. The living area and bedrooms have full height ceiling into the roof space with some exposed beams. The Wain house sleeps up to 5 people and has 2 bedrooms and a well sprung bed settee in the lounge.

Key Collection, Welcome and Car Parking

The details of location for the door key will be sent to you by us prior to your holiday.

- Parking is available for 2 cars near the front door of the Wain house
- The parking area has a gravel surface with a smooth walkway 6mts from the front door.
- This area is well lit at night by motion sensor lights.

Entrance to Property

- The front door is 96cm wide, enters into open plan kitchen diner/lounge.
- There is a slightly sloping path with a 2cm lip at the door way.
- The property is all on one level and tiled threw out.

Sitting Room/Lounge

- The sitting room/lounge is open plan with kitchen/diner. The lounge has a mixture of seating with sofa and soft chairs, with non-feather cushions, together with a nest of coffee tables and a removable rug and a wood burning stove.

- Furniture can be moved.
- There is a widescreen digital television with remote control, subtitles, and a DVD player.
- Lighting is natural daylight with ceiling lighting and standard lamp.

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Dining Area

- The dining area has table measuring 63 cm floor to lowest point of table, 153 cm long, 88 cm wide and 5 chairs. The dining table (moveable side to side) has legs on each corner.
- There is free space around the table.
- Chairs (all moveable) – 5 chairs with padded seats that have no arms.
- Lighting is natural daylight with ceiling lighting.

Kitchen

- There are double doors 170 cm wide 2cm lip from kitchen to outside decking area.
- The work top height is 93 cm.
- Electric oven with drop down door and hob above.
- Worktop and sink are 930mm/36.6ins above the floor the sink as lever taps.
- Fridge and a freezer are both available,
- Glasses and crockery can be moved from wall cupboards to
- Glasses can be placed in lower cupboards, if required, please request this when booking.
- Large cutlery and utensils, cordless kettle and a toaster.
- The kitchen has lights above work surfaces.
- Microwave on work surface.
- Front loading dish washer 44 cm wide.
- Washing machine front loading fully automatic.
- From kitchen door into hall with hanging pegs opening into two bedrooms and shower room.

Bedrooms and Sleeping Areas

- Master Bedroom, Door width 75 cm.
- Super King size zip and link bed (6ft), Bed height 68 cm floor to top of mattress.
- Non feather duvets and pillows provided.
- Clearance at end of bed to wall 80 cm.
- Bedside cabinets are 60 cm high.
- Largest clear space of doors and furniture is 230 cm by 135cm.
- Bed side rugs can be removed.

Twin Bedroom

- Door width 75 cm.
- Two single 3ft zip and link beds provided, can change into 6ft super king by request when booking.
- Bed high 60 cm floor to top of mattress.
- Non feather duvets and pillows provided.
- Bedside cabinets are 63 cm.
- Bed side rugs can be removed.

Shower-room and Toilet

- Door width 65 cm.
- Room measures 340cm by 180cm.
- Well lit with over head lights and light over mirror.
- Flexible shower with wall mounted shower seat measuring 48cm from lowest point of seat to floor and grab rail.
- Toilet seat height 49cm with a folding safety hand rail.
- Wash basin 84cm high with lever taps.
- Flooring tiled with a bath mat.
- Heated towel rail.

Garden

- The enclosed exterior decking can be accessed via double patio doors 170cm wide from the kitchen/dining area or from the car park on a smooth gentle sloping
- 115cm wide path with 90cm high hand rail, the path moving onto the lawn area with patio table chairs.

Additional Information

- There are no stairs in the Wainhouse and no steps in the outside patio/garden area
- Heating is provided by oil under floor heating and with a wood burning stove in the lounge with a fire guard.
- A vibrating alarm clock is available to use in any of the bedrooms on request.
- Assistance dogs are welcome.
- Up to two well behaved dogs are allowed by prior arrangement.

- Good mobile phone reception with orange, other operators vary
- The nearest General Hospital with an A&E unit and walk in NHS is 2 miles away and the nearest Doctor's surgery is 8 miles away. Further information is in the welcome folder.
